



Fuel Distribution System Operator

The Fuel Distribution System Operator (FDSO) is responsible for the safe and efficient operation of bulk petroleum storage and distribution systems at federal installations.

Working at the journeyman level, FDSOs perform hands-on fuel operations, from receiving and inventorying products to issuing fuel to military refueling vehicles, in full compliance with safety, security, and environmental requirements.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Daily Operations
 - Conduct daily inspections of fuel systems, storage tanks, pipelines, and associated components.
 - Configure fuel storage tanks for bulk issue and receipt operations.
 - Operate the pumphouse to issue fuel to military refueling vehicles.
 - Transfer fuel products between storage and distribution systems.
- Receipt & Inventory
 - Receive fuel products delivered by commercial tank trucks.
 - Inventory fuel products and maintain accurate records.
 - Perform operator maintenance on petroleum systems and equipment.
- Safety & Housekeeping
 - Follow all established safety, security, and environmental requirements at all times.
 - Perform general housekeeping responsibilities for all facilities.
 - Must be able to lift and carry up to 40 lbs.

Required Qualifications:

- Experience
 - Commercial or military experience in operating fuel bulk storage and distribution systems and equipment — preferred.
 - Experience performing tasks equivalent to Military Service journeyman-level operator personnel, or conforming to a similar commercial or military standards.
 - Physical & Other
 - Ability to lift and carry up to 40 lbs.
 - Ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions around fuel systems, tanks, and heavy equipment.
 - Have and maintain a CDL license where applicable
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Work Conditions & Physical Requirements

- Work is performed in both office environments and on terminal grounds, including outdoor exposure to all weather conditions
 - Must be able to work around petroleum storage tanks, pipelines, and heavy equipment
 - PPE is required in designated areas per safety regulations
 - On-call availability for emergencies, spills, or critical operational events may be required
